

2018-2019 5th Grade Supply List

The following list of supplies will be needed regardless of whom your child has in the upcoming school year:

- Bible (NKJV; others are fine) – this Bible **MUST** stay in school.
- Pencils (at least 24 sharpened or mechanical); replace as needed.
- Erasers (pencil topper or hand held)
- 1 pack of red or purple pens for grading
- 1 pack of colored markers
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 1 - 4-packs of THIN dry erase markers
- 1 pack of yellow highlighters
- Scissors
- 1 roll of clear Scotch tape
- 2 - 3 packs of Post-it-Notes (any color)
- 3 –100 pack of 3x5 lined index cards
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags
- A small container for art supplies (no larger than 5" x 8"—NOTE: **DO NOT** purchase the hard plastic boxes. The soft zippered kind or a binder pencil pouch is what is required.)
- Zippered pencil case for pencils, erasers and pens
- One 1 inch Binder **OR** one sturdy expanding file (student's choice)
- 1-inch binder (separate from above) for writing/grammar curriculum with 8 separate tabbed inserts
- 3 – 2 pocket plastic folders for the binder only (must have holes to use in binder) – **not needed if you chose the expanding file.**
- 3 packs of loose leaf paper (wide-ruled)
- 5 Marble Composition books
- 3 **plastic**, 2-pocket folders **with fasteners** (1 – red, 1 – yellow, 1 – green)
- ALL textbooks **MUST** be covered in brown paper. Please save at least 5 large brown paper bags for the beginning of the school year. **NO** book covers please!
- One roll of clear contact paper to cover workbooks – Needed for summer project (**DO NOT** put it off! The stores run out quickly.) **Keep this at home to cover workbooks** 😊
- A bag of candy (non-peanut items)
- A free standing, wire locker shelf (optional)
- A combination lock (no key or laser locks) (optional)
- A reading book of choice for silent reading. Must have the first day of school.
- A completed Summer Reading Packet

You may wish to purchase more pencils, pens, paper, etc. while there are summer sales because students will be responsible to replace items if their supply runs out during the school year.
